YMCA Camp Michindoh

August 12 – 14, 2022

THE BASICS

Camp occurs every fall, and it's a great way to kick off our concert season and school year. Most students say it's the highlight of their year, and one of the top highlights of their orchestra experience at Athens. It is a 3-day, 2-night camp covering August 13, 14, 15 at YMCA Camp Michindoh in the beautiful wilderness near Hillsdale (approx. 2.5 hours southwest of Troy). While there, students will get world-class instruction from some of the best music educators in the state of Michigan. Students will also get free time to spend together doing activities provided by the camp, such as water slides, inflatable water park, canoeing, and recreational sports. At the end of camp on Sunday, we will perform a concert for you to kick off our school year. Camp is not mandatory, but *strongly encouraged*. It's a great way to meet people and bond with your orchestra family. **This is going to be a great way to kick-start our program regeneration after a year of Covid. We strongly encourage you to attend!**

FORMS

2 weeks before attending camp, all students must complete the **HEALTH FORM**. We prefer that this is done using our secure online format: <https://www.athensorchestras.com/fall-camp.html>. Food allergies are included in the health history form.

MUSIC

Music will be chosen and posted/sent prior to camp. You must print your own part. You may "go paperless" and use your iPad for your music, but you **MUST** have an effective and fast way to notate the music during rehearsal. You must also make sure your iPad is charged for every rehearsal.

PAYMENT & REGISTRATION

Payment for camp is done all online. *Camp cost is \$170 per person*. Registering for camp means you have paid the down payment. Payment of camp includes all transportation, meals, all activities provided by the camp, overnight stay for two nights, and limited-edition camp t-shirt. **Down payment with registration of any amount to hold your spot is due by June 30, 2022.** Remaining balances must be paid by August 7, 2022 to attend Camp.

TRANSPORTATION

Busing will be provided TO camp on Friday, August 12 by bus. We will leave from Athens High School student parking lot, by the football field. Students will not be able to get inside the building. **Please note there IS BUS TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED BACK TO ATHENS ON SUNDAY AUGUST 14. The final performance will be at Athens High School on Sunday August 15 at 4:00 pm. Please join us at that time for the final concert and to pick up your child. Please see attached time schedule.**

Thursday August 11

4 - 5:00pm: The equipment trailer will be open for students to drop off cellos and basses. **Please make sure your instrument is tagged with your first and last name.** If you cannot make this time, the trailer will be open from 6:30am on Friday the 12th until our departure at 7am. Once the seniors leave Athens at 6:30am, the trailer will be unavailable. ***This is for cello and bass players only, all violins and violas will be transported on the bus with their student's luggage.*** The school will NOT be open at this time.

What Should I Pack?

There may be items missing from this list. You are trusted to bring the appropriate items and clothing.

- INSTRUMENT – LABELED WITH YOUR NAME
- MUSIC + PENCIL – LABELED WITH YOUR NAME
- MUSIC STAND – BOTH PARTS LABELED WITH YOUR NAME
- Sleeping bag and/or blankets + pillow
- Jacket/outerwear
- CLOSED TOED SHOES (for camp activities)
- **SWIMSUIT: Ladies must wear ONE PIECE swimsuits. This is a YMCA rule. If you do not own a 1-piece, you may wear a dark colored t-shirt over your bathing suit. Men must wear traditional swim trunks.**
- Warm clothing
- Day clothes
- Bathroom items/accessories
- Shower items + shower shoes (you will share the shower houses with your bunkmates) + TOWELS
- Any applicable medicines, including pain relief medication (the first aid kit is for emergencies only)
- **Sunscreen & bug spray**
- **Closed-toed shoes & appropriate shoes for the water front**
- **Flashlight/headlamp**
- **Water bottle**
- Cards/games/books/leisure items (includes additional instruments such as guitars, ukuleles, etc.)
- Sunglasses
- Hand sanitizer and extra masks if desired. We will have sanitizer on site and will be regularly disinfecting shared surfaces. We are NOT providing extra masks.
- Cash, if you have a desire to use the vending machines on campus or purchase emergency items from camp store.

*****Be advised that the TSD and Athens Student Code of Conduct AND DRESS CODE are in effect for this trip, as it is an extension of the school day.**

*****Please note you are NOT to bring snack/food into the cabins, this is a Camp Michindoh's policy. If you decide to bring snacks, be prepared to face the consequences of your actions. We will have "community" snacks for all students, they will be nut-free and as allergy friendly as possible.**

Instruments

- **All instrument cases, music, and all parts of your personal music stand need to be labeled with first and last names.**
- **CELLOS AND BASSES WILL BE USING THE TRAILER TO TRANSPORT THEIR INSTRUMENT.** They will not go on the bus. Please see schedule for THURSDAY to drop off your instrument on the trailer.
- **If you plan to use a school cello or bass, you need to come to the school on Thursday during the open trailer time to pack your instrument up and put it on the trailer. Those are the only times the school and trailer will be open. You may send someone else with your instrument to put it on the trailer if you are not able to make it.**

Bunks

We will have safety and cleaning protocols in place to make sure bunks are as safe as possible for our students.

- **All students** have been assigned bunk mates and cabins. When you get to the camp, your senior leaders will take you to your cabin
- **There will be senior leaders in each cabin.** All cabins hold at least 12 students, with almost all cabins having between 8-10 people occupancy. There will be 2 cabins that are for the adult chaperones, centrally and easily located.
- **Your cabin will have air conditioning.**
- All cabins have at least one attached bathroom.
- *You are to stay in your own cabin. If you would like to enjoy the company of another person, please do so at a general meeting space. There is no reason to go into someone else's cabin.*
- *****Please note you are NOT to bring snack items into the cabins, this is a Camp Michindoh's policy. If you decide to bring snacks, be prepared to face consequences of your actions.**

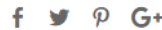

2. Using the drop down menu, choose the **amount** you wish to pay at this time. Enter your child's **first and last name**, and then the quantity you wish you pay for (for siblings) and then click **ADD TO CART**.
 - a. Down payment for camp (any amount to hold your place), due by June 30. After that, you can choose to pay in any installments equaling up to \$170. *Please note that your child will not be permitted to attend camp if they have not paid the full amount by AUGUST 10.* You may pay two ways, using a credit/debit card, or using a PayPal account (if you have one - ****NOT REQUIRED.**)

3. Click **CHECKOUT** to review your order. Click **CHECKOUT** again if all information is correct. Then enter your EMAIL ADDRESS, FIRST AND LAST NAMES, AND PHONE NUMBER. Click next.
